

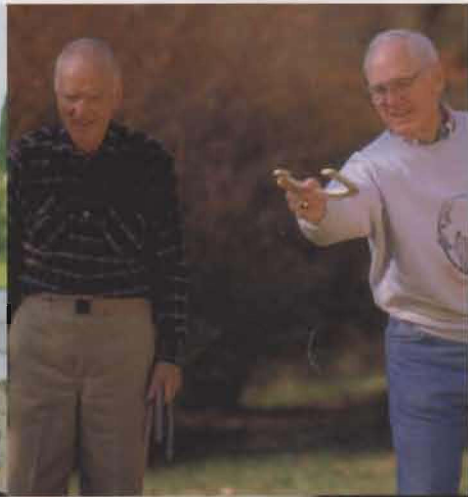

Independent Living

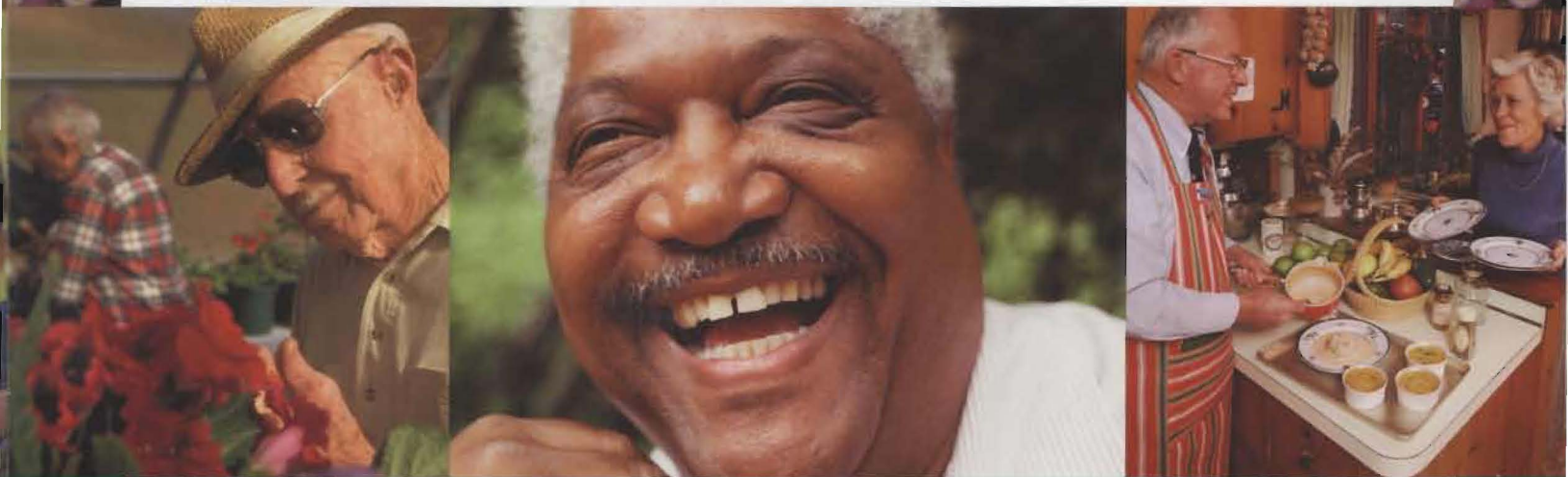
